## *Environment department to develop 3 beaches*

Mangaluru: Three beaches from the coastal districts will be adopted and developed by the department of forest ecology and environment. In this regard, cleaning and maintenance work at Iddya-Surathkal beach in Dakshina Kannada, Kodi beach in Iddupi and Gokarna beach in Uttara Kannada will begin from Tuesday

Dr Dinesh Kumar Y K, DCE forest ecology and environment, told TOI that the beach stretch from Iddya to Surathkallighthouse (northwards) has been selected in Dakshina Kannada.

Priority will be on the cleaning of beaches. The department is adopting three beaches for the first time in the state. The adoption is funded by the Environment Management and Policy Research Institute, under the central government's Swachh Bharat Harith Bharat programme, be added.

On the one hand, while the tourism department has decided to develop beaches in a phased manner, the de-



partment of forest ecology and environment believes s that this is the first step towards obtaining Blue Flag certification.

"The beaches will be adopted till March and cleanliness drives will be undertaken with the support of local organisations. Permanent staff will be appointed for cleaning and spreading awareness on the do's and dont's at the beaches. The idea is to develop the beaches with sufficient greenery. This is an initial development plan for the beaches, "Dr Dinesh said.

## Eco-park to developed on 14 acres on Kodi Beach

Generally, beaches are being maintained by the tourism department, and a few of them are being developed on a PPP model. However, for these three beaches, the next phase of development will be undertaken at an approximate cost of Rs 8-Rst0 coree each. Recently, a team of officials visited the Kodi beach in Kundapur:

The three beaches will have two permanent employees to keep the stretch clean and water the plants. These employees will also act as lifeguards.

Meanwhile, the department is considering developing an eco-park on 14 acres at Kodi Beach.
