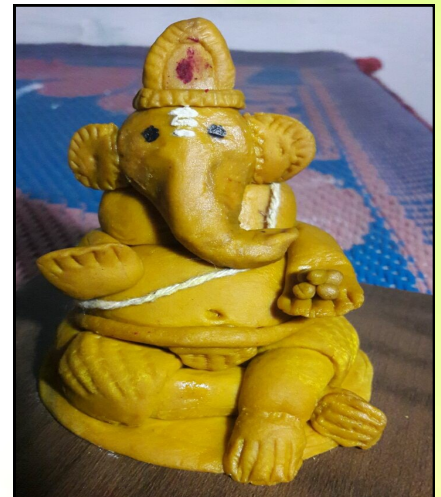
Turmeric Ganesha Campaign

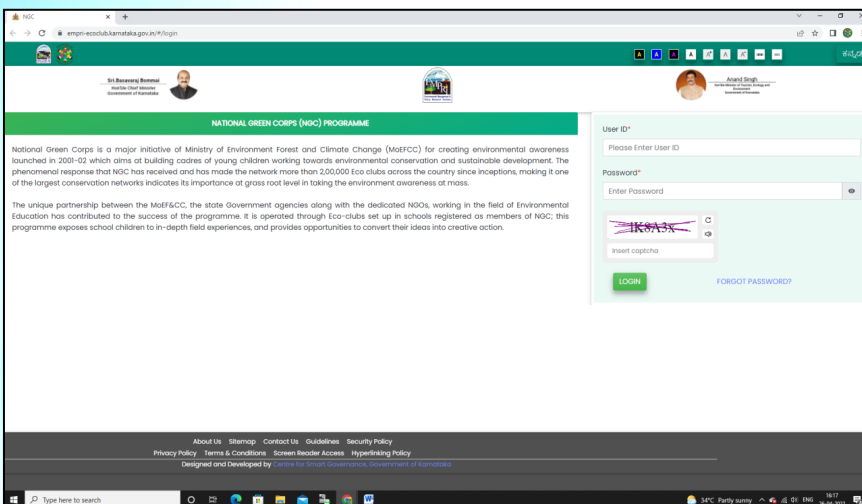
NGC Handbooks & Makkala Chandada Parisara books


